

## Potter Township Zoning Regulations for ALL Areas



### WINTER TOWNSHIP ROAD SAFETY

At this time of year, residents are reminded to *avoid parking on Township roads*, which is prohibited year-round but is hazardous when plows are at work. Fines may be incurred for each infraction and vehicles may be impounded for frequent or continuing infractions.

When clearing your driveway, please *do not push snow out onto the road*. Whether shoveled or plowed, snow must remain on your property and not be put on Township roads or rights-of-way. This can cause another driver to have a serious accident when driving through the mound of snow.



This also interferes with the Township's ability to plow and maintain the roadways.



Also... please *make sure your mailbox post is secure* during snow plowing season!
